# Note

## 1. Introduction

AVITW's two booklets entitled:

- **The Feast Days of the God of Israel**
  - **The Sacred Calendar of the God of Israel**
- provide a full explanation for each question pertaining to why Christians should observe the biblical Feasts. Please read them before writing to us concerning the information on this card. This brief note provides additional information concerning why, in certain years, the Feast Day dates shown here differ from the dates in the popular Jewish calendar.

## 2. The Years 2019, 2024 & 2027

You will notice from the chart overleaf in these years, AVITW has started the year a month before the popular Jewish calendar. The reason is: **we have selected the new moon nearest the true equinox (20 March) to begin Abib (Nisan).** In year 2019, this conjunction occurs on March 6<sup>th</sup> at 18:04 hours (Jerusalem Time) and the new moon is expected to be seen on the morning of March 8<sup>th</sup>, thus making March 8<sup>th</sup> the 1<sup>st</sup> of Abib.

## 3. Signs in the Sky

Many believers become polarized about the matter of keeping the correct Feast Days. It is, of course, vitally important; and that is why AVITW makes such an effort to get it right. Let no one forget, the **GREAT FEASTS (the realities to which all current Feasts point) will be miraculously highlighted by signs in the sun, moon and stars!** We will not then be dependent upon computer printouts, or the knowledge and skill of leaders feverishly arguing amongst themselves as to who is correct.

**In the near future, there shall be SIGNS IN THE SKY, which will clearly indicate the correct Feast Days, Sacred Seasons or Sabbatical Year just as they did when the Savior hung on the cross.** On that occasion, the sun went out for over three hours. That was no eclipse by any means; for an eclipse lasts only a few minutes.

*Now from the sixth hour there was darkness over all the land unto the ninth hour.*  
(Matthew 27:45)

When the Savior died on that memorable day, even the Roman soldier confessed: **"Truly this was the Son of God."**

It will be the same in the near future; the promised signs in the sun, moon and stars will point to the sacred times for all to see. Look out for these celestial signs at the Feasts!

*But take ye heed: behold, I have foretold you all things. But in those days, after that tribulation, the sun shall be darkened, and the moon shall not give her light, And the stars of heaven shall fall, and the powers that are in heaven shall be shaken.*  
(Mark 13:23-25)

## Pentecost

For believers who count to Pentecost from the *morrow after the weekly Sabbath*, Pentecost will occur on the Sunday following the date shown for the year 2019.

Whichever set of dates you settle on, make sure you are looking out for the **SIGNS in the sun, moon and stars.** The Almighty will certainly keep His promise in Genesis 1:14 to signal the **Feast Days, Sacred Seasons and Years** in His calendar.

*And God said, Let there be lights in the firmament of the heaven to divide the day from the night; and let them be for SIGNS, and for seasons, and for days, and years:*  
(Genesis 1:14)
